Dear Colonel Buono:

The New Mexico Environment Department is approving a Class 3 Permit Modification to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit issued to Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB). The modification consists of approval of Corrective Action Complete (CAC) status for 32 solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs), based on the Corrective Action Complete proposals submitted by CAFB in July 2008, October 2010, and April 2013. Thirteen SWMUs were issued CAC with controls status and were moved from Table 1 to Table 2 of Attachment 1 of the Permit. Nineteen SWMUs/AOCs were issued CAC without controls status and were moved from Table 1 to Table 3 of Attachment 1 of the Permit.

In accordance with section 20.4.1.901 of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), NMED provided public notice and conducted a 60-day public comment period from September 19, 2014 through November 18, 2014. No comments were received during the public comment period.

The Permit as modified becomes effective thirty days after the date of the approval of this Permit Modification and may be appealed under the provisions of 20.4.1.901(h) NMAC and §74-4-14 of the Hazardous Waste Act.
