The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 received a citizen petition letter dated November 21, 2013, from Mr. David McCoy of Albuquerque, New Mexico. Mr. McCoy's citizen petition letter is requesting a Preliminary Assessment (PA) under Section 105(d) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) for the Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) jet fuel spill in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Executive Order 12580, Section 3, delegates the responsibilities for Section 105(d) to the lead Federal Agency, which is the Air Force at KAFB.
