
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the U.S. Air Force's (Permittee) submission dated June 21, 2012: *Additional Groundwater Monitoring Wells Addendum to Groundwater Investigation Work Plan, March 2011, Bulk Fuels Facility Spill, Solid Waste Management Units ST-106 and SS-111* (Work Plan), dated June 13, 2012. NMED approves the subject work plan.

The Permittee is directed to proceed with implementation of the well installations as provided in the approved Work Plan. The Permittee requested in the transmittal letter for the Work Plan a time extension to complete the well installations from the original due date of July 31, 2012 to September 30, 2012. The Permittee did not provide cause for such extension pursuant to the Permittee's Hazardous Waste Treatment Facility Operating Permit, Part 1, Section 1.38. NMED is unable to consider an extension since the Permittee did not provide a rationale for the request.
