In fact, the new Consent Order limits public participation in influencing decisions which affect our lives. We need a list of the status of all cleanup areas, with history and updates. All documents must be accessible and clear. Future cleanup must have enforceable deadlines, with the dates and schedule for completion available for review. The public must be notified in a timely manner of public hearings on the new Consent Order.
