**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND EXTENDED PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON
A DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT FOR TRIASSIC PARK WASTE DISPOSAL
FACILITY, EPA ID NUMBER: NM0001002484**

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued a public notice on June 15, 2016 concerning the intent to issue a Hazardous Waste Permit to Gandy Marley, Inc. (GMI) as the owner and operator of the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility (Facility) to dispose of hazardous waste under the federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (Chapter 74, Article 4 NMSA 1978, or the HWA) and also announcing a 60-day comment period that was scheduled to end on August 14, 2016. On August 12, 2016, NMED extended the public comment period through **5:00 p.m. MDT on November 18, 2016**, to receive additional comment on this action.

NMED is announcing a public informational meeting to be held on **October 22, 2016** from **1:00pm to 3:00pm** at the following address:

All members of the public are invited to attend. The public meeting will include a brief presentation on the draft Hazardous Waste Permit followed by a question and answer period. Written comments must be based on the information available for review and include, to the extent practicable, all referenced factual materials. Documents in the administrative record need not be re-submitted if expressly referenced by the commenter. Requests for a Public Hearing shall provide: (1) a clear and concise factual statement of the nature and scope of the interest of the person requesting the hearing; (2) the name and address of all persons whom the requester represents; (3) a statement of any objections to the draft permit; and (4) a statement of the issues which the commenter proposes to raise for consideration at the hearing. NMED will provide a minimum 30 day notice of a Public Hearing, if scheduled.

After consideration of all the written public comments received, NMED will issue or modify and issue the draft permit. NMED will respond to all written comments received, in writing upon issuance of the final Permit. If NMED modifies the draft permit, NMED will provide to the Permittee a copy of the modified draft permit and a detailed written statement containing the reasons for the modifications by mail.

NMED will make the final decision publicly available and will notify the Permittee by certified mail. The final decision will constitute a final agency decision and may be appealed as provided by the HWA.
