On September 17, 2012, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued an initial public notice to submit public comment and requests for public hearing by November 16, 2012. Since issuance of that initial notice, NMED has received requests to extend the public comment period.

The public comment period shall be extended for an additional ninety days. NMED will now receive comments and requests for public hearing through **5:00 p.m. MST, February 14, 2013.**

NMED issues this public notice on November 20, 2012, to announce the extension the comment period that will end at **5:00 p.m. MST, February 14, 2013**. Only comments and/or requests received before **5:00 p.m. MST on February 14, 2013** will be considered.

Written comments must be based on all reasonably available information and include, to the extent practicable, all referenced factual materials. Documents in the administrative record need not be resubmitted if expressly referenced by the commenter. Requests for a public hearing shall provide: (1) a clear and concise factual statement of the nature and scope of the interest of the person requesting the hearing; (2) the name and address of all persons whom the requestor represents; (3) a statement of any objections to the draft Permit, including specific references to any Permit conditions being addressed; and (4) a statement of the issues which the commenter proposes to raise for consideration at the hearing. Written comment and requests for Public Hearing must be filed with Mr. William Moats on or before **5:00 p.m. MST, February 14, 2013**. NMED will provide a thirty (30) day notice of a public hearing, if granted.

NMED must ensure that the approved draft Permit is consistent with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC). All written comments submitted on the draft Permit will be considered in formulating a final decision and may cause the draft Permit to be modified. NMED will respond in writing to all public comments. NMED's response will specify which provision, if any, of the draft Permit have been changed in the final Permit decision, the reasons for the change, and briefly describe and respond to all public comments on the draft Permit or the Permit application raised during the public comment period. All persons presenting written comments or who requested notification in writing will be notified of NMED's decision by mail. This response will also be posted on the NMED website.

After consideration of all the written public comments received, NMED will issue, or modify and issue the Permit. If NMED modifies and issues the Permit, the applicant shall be provided by mail a copy of the modified Permit and a detailed written statement of reasons for the modifications. The Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department will make the final Permit decision publicly available and shall notify the applicant by certified mail. The Secretary's decision shall constitute a final agency decision and may be appealed as provided by the Hazardous Waste Act (Chapter 74, Article 4 NMSA 1978).
