

WIPP Daily Summary 05-06-2014

- The FAS filter has been returned to WIPP. The initial evaluation of results indicates that high activity Am-241 is causing interfering energy peaks for detection of other isotopes, which may be present. The FAS filter will be sent to SRNL, targeting Wednesday.
- WIPP Transportation is looking into providing type A packaging to support additional sample shipments for analysis.
- The 151 CAM cartridge and maslin large area wipes are ready to be sent to SRNL Wednesday.
- The next WIPP entry has been postponed until Thursday at the soonest to allow for assessment of hazards and controls to be addressed.
- WCS is 50% complete with single stacking and segregating the SWBs containing the target waste stream. They expect to complete this evolution Wednesday.
