
FIRST PREHEARING PROCEDURAL ORDER

Upon a pre-hearing conference before the Hearing Officer with the following parties: the New Mexico Environment Department (“NMED”), the Dairy Industry Group for a Clean Environment (“DIGCE”), and Amigos Bravos, Caballo Concerned Citizens Group, Food and Water Watch and the Sierra Club (“Coalition”); the Hearing Officer having considered the requests of the parties, the administrative efficiency of the hearing, and being otherwise fully advised;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The hearing in this matter shall commence with public comment.
2. The Hearing Officer will allow for public comment each day of hearing at three different times during the day: morning, mid-day, and afternoon.
3. The parties will present their case before the Commission in the following order: (a) NMED; (b) Coalition; and (c) DIGCE.
4. The order of examination for each party shall be as follows: (a) opening statement, if any; (b) direct presentation of surrebuttal testimony; (c) cross-examination of witnesses by other parties; and (d) redirect examination.

5. The Coalition shall be permitted to offer telephonic testimony of Kendall Thu. The Hearing Officer shall take reasonable efforts to allow or facilitate the presentation of Mr. Thu's testimony.
6. Prehearing motions in this matter, if any, shall be filed by the following deadlines:
 - A. Prehearing motions: Tuesday, April 6, 2010 at 3:00 PM
 - B. Responses to Prehearing Motions: Friday, April 9, 2010 at 3:00 PM
