**JOINT MOTION TO RESCHEDULE RESUMPTION OF HEARING**

---

The New Mexico Environment Department ("Department"), Amigos Bravos, Caballo Concerned Citizens Group, Food and Water Watch and the Sierra Club Rio Grande Chapter ("Coalition"), and the Dairy Industry Group for a Clean Environment ("DIGCE"), (collectively "the Signatories"), file this Joint Motion to Reschedule the Resumption of the Hearing in this matter from the dates of May 6, 7, 10, 11 and 13, 2010 to dates available to the Hearing Officer beginning with the Commission's June 8, 2010 open meeting and continuing into the week of June 14 if necessary. As grounds for this motion, the Signatories state as follows:

1. The hearing in this matter has been held on April 13, 14, 15 and 16, 2010. At the end of the hearing on April 16th, the Hearing Officer urged the parties to meet and work out technical issues before the next scheduled hearing date. The hearing is scheduled to resume on May 6, 7, 10, 11 and 13, 2010. The signatories believe that if the resumption of the hearing is delayed until June, they may be able to clarify language and

resolve some issues related to the Department's proposed Dairy Rule, and reduce hearing time. The signatories therefore request that the Hearing Officer schedule resumption of the hearing for days available to the hearing officer beginning with the Commission's June 8, 2010 open meeting, to continue into the following week if necessary.

2. The Department contacted the counsel for participants who have filed Notices of Intent to Present Technical Testimony in this matter and each joins in this motion.

3. A proposed Order is attached.

WHEREFORE, the Signatories respectfully request that the Hearing Officer enter an order rescheduling the resumption of hearings to begin on June 8, and continuing thereafter until concluded, as determined by the Hearing Officer.
