**NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT TO HOLD
PUBLIC MEETING ON THURSDAY AUGUST 30, 2012 IN CORRALES**

Meeting To Discuss Proposed Discharge Permit for Corrales Senior Living (DP-1774)

WHAT: The New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED) Ground Water Quality Bureau (GWQB) will hold an informational meeting to discuss the proposed Discharge Permit for the Corrales Senior Living center. The manager of the facility, David Dronet, proposes to discharge up to 30,000 gallons per day of domestic wastewater to a package treatment plant. Potential contaminants associated with this type of discharge include nitrogen compounds. The facility is located at 35 Sandia View Lane, in Corrales, in Sections 26 and 27, T12N, R03E, Sandoval County. Ground water beneath the site is at a depth of approximately 54 feet and has a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 374 milligrams per liter.
