Ground Water Quality Bureau Seeks Feedback on Services

(Santa Fe, NM) – The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is seeking feedback from ground water discharge permit applicants and the general public on services offered by the Ground Water Quality Bureau. The department has developed an online customer satisfaction survey to assess the level of service provided by the bureau.

“In order to maintain ground water quality while simultaneously fostering economic development, we need candid input from stakeholders involved in the permitting process,” says Ryan Flynn, General Counsel for the NMED.

The feedback generated from this survey will help the department identify where improvements can be made to better serve the public.
