The New Mexico Environment Department will hold a public meeting on Tuesday July 24, 2012, at 1:00 P.M. to discuss stakeholder involvement in the investigation and development of potential alternatives to the Federal Implementation Plan for Interstate Transport of Pollution Affecting Visibility and Best Available Retrofit Technology (76 Fed. Reg. 52,388) for the San Juan Generating Station. The meeting will be hosted by the New Mexico Environment Department at the San Juan College at the Lecture Hall (Room 7103), which is located at 4601 College Blvd, Farmington, NM 87402.

The purpose of the meeting will be to inform the public about the current status of the regional haze dispute and receive public comments on a proposed stakeholder outreach process for identifying a viable alternative to the plans previously adopted by the Environmental Protection Agency and the State of New Mexico.
