Environment Department Lifts “Precautionary Boil Water Advisory” For the Community Served by the Ruidoso Water System

(Santa Fe, N.M.) –The New Mexico Environment Department’s (NMED) Drinking Water Bureau has lifted the “precautionary boil water advisory” for the Ruidoso Water System.

NMED issued the precautionary advisory on July 5, 2013 following a report by the water system of problems with treatment at the Grindstone Treatment Plant. These issues have been resolved and the treatment plant is operating properly. The Ruidoso Water System is located in Ruidoso, NM in Lincoln County. The Ruidoso Water System serves about 10,800 people. NMED recommends that Ruidoso Water System notify water consumers that the precautionary advisory has been lifted.
