### **New Mexico Environment Department Air Quality Bureau Hosting Annual Smoke Management Meetings**

**Santa Fe, NM** – The New Mexico Environment Department’s Air Quality Bureau will be hosting their Annual Smoke Management Meeting for the southern part of the state in Socorro on Tuesday, February 11, 2014 from 1:00 to 4:00 pm at the Bureau of Land Management Socorro Field Office, 901 South Highway 85.

The meeting for the northern part of the state will be held in Santa Fe on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 from 1:00 to 4:00 pm at the Toney Anaya Building, 2550 Cerrillos Road, on the second floor in the Rio Grande Conference Room.

An annual meeting is held each year in order to bring together people who use or are affected by the New Mexico Smoke Management Program. This program was developed to protect the health and welfare of New Mexicans from the impacts of smoke from all sources of fire. Participants include federal, state, county and municipal fire managers and private citizens who participate in the program to conduct prescribed burns and manage wildfires.

Presenters at this year’s meeting will discuss Smoke Management updates, smoke emissions, and the results of the Department of Health study on smoke impacts in Albuquerque from the 2011 Wallow Fire. There will also be presentations about some of the larger upcoming 2014 planned prescribed burns.
