## **NMED Will Hold Fruit Avenue Plume Superfund Site Meeting Thursday in Albuquerque**

**WHAT:** The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the City of Albuquerque will hold a community meeting to discuss changes to the Record of Decision (ROD) concerning the Fruit Avenue Plume Superfund Site. Certain components in the ROD, which includes remedies for the plume, are no longer required. Other portions of the remedy, including a ground water monitoring system and the limitation of groundwater use at the site are in place and serve to protect human health and the environment.

**WHEN:** At 7 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 31.

**WHO:** Staff members from NMED, EPA will discuss the changes.
