Environment Secretary, State Engineer to Address Water Quantity and Quality Issues Wednesday in Rio Rancho

(Santa Fe, NM) —New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Secretary Ron Curry and State Engineer John D'Antonio will speak Wednesday, May 7th at a public meeting of the Middle Rio Grande Water Quality Standards Work Group in Rio Rancho.

The group brings together state, local and tribal officials to resolve differences over water issues and improve the water quality in the Middle Rio Grande Region. Representatives of the City of Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, the City of Rio Rancho, and the Pueblos of Santa Ana and Sandia are expected to attend Wednesday's meeting. Secretary Curry and State Engineer D'Antonio will present the group with their priorities for and take questions on water quality and quantity in New Mexico.

The meeting will be held from 8:30 am - noon on Wednesday, May 7 in the City of Rio Rancho Council Chambers, 1781 Rio Rancho Blvd., the corner of 528 and 19th St.
