New Mexico Climate Change Advisory Group Will Meet For Final Time Next Week

WHAT: The New Mexico Climate Change Advisory Group will convene for a final meeting lasting two days to make recommendations to give Gov. Richardson on how the state can reduce its greenhouse gas emissions. The Governor appointed members of the state's Climate Change Advisory Group a year and three months ago to analyze and develop policy recommendations for those goals. The group is considering 67 policy recommendations that affect transportation, land use, energy supply, agriculture, forestry, and residential, commercial and industrial operations. There will be opportunity for public input on Oct. 31.
