Public Meeting Concerning Proposed LES Uranium Enrichment Facility in Eunice to be Held Oct. 5 in Lea County

WHAT: The public is invited to attend a meeting concerning the groundwater discharge permit (DP-1481) for the proposed Louisiana Energy Services Enrichment Facility about four miles east of Eunice, N.M. The permit would allow for a storm water pond, a sewage treatment system and two evaporation ponds that would hold industrial wastewater from the proposed plant.
