NMED's Occupational Health and Safety Bureau and American Subcontractor's Association of New Mexico Hold Press Conference On Workers' Safety Agreement

WHAT: New Mexico Environment Department's Occupational Health and Safety Bureau (NM OSHA) and the American Subcontractors Association of New Mexico (ASANM) will sign a partnership agreement to help create safer working conditions for the state's subcontractors. The agreement is the first partnership program of its kind between a state OSHA program and an American Subcontractors Association (ASA) chapter.
