## **Environment Department Offers Free Testing of Residential Well Water Tomorrow in Hobbs**

### **The Department Will Also Offer Information about Septic Systems**

**WHO:** The New Mexico Environment Department's Environmental Health Division will offer free testing of private well water at the Healthy Living Fair. Water will be tested for nitrates, fluoride and iron. Residents should bring at least two cups of water in an enclosed, clean container.

The department will also provide information on food facility permitting and food safety, and permitting for on-site liquid wastewater treatment systems.
