(Santa Fe, NM) State and federal agencies and private companies are planning the fifteenth annual New Mexico Infrastructure Finance Conference from Oct. 26 through Oct. 28 at Hotel Encanto de las Cruces.

The theme of this year's conference is "Infrastructure 2010: Building Toward Sustainability."
