Environment Department issues Precautionary Boil Advisory for Ruidoso, New Mexico

(Santa Fe, NM) New Mexico Environment Department Secretary David Martin has issued a Precautionary Boil Water Advisory for Ruidoso, New Mexico. Due to extreme weather conditions, many water lines in Ruidoso have frozen and broken. Residents in that area are encouraged to boil their water until further notice.

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Environmental Health Division has also closed some restaurants that currently have no water and they are asking other restaurants in Ruidoso to close if they have no water at this time. NMED inspectors are working with restaurants and other food facilities to reopen as soon as possible.
