### **Environment Department Lifts “Boil Water Advisory” for Tecolote Water System**

(Santa Fe, NM) –The New Mexico Environment Department’s Drinking Water Bureau is lifting a “boil water advisory” for the Tecolote Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Association (MDWCA) Water System.

NMED issued the advisory on August 2, 2010 after bacteriological contamination that exceeded the Maximum Contaminant Level for *E. coli* was discovered in the water system. NMED required the Tecolote Water System to notify all water consumers of the finding.

Corrective actions were taken by the water system, including disinfecting the water system by increasing the level of chlorination and identifying possible sources of contamination. Consumers were advised to boil all water prior to ingestion.

Water samples collected since the corrective actions were taken have shown no *E. coli* present in the water system. These clean results have allowed NMED’s Drinking Water Bureau to advise the Tecolote MDWCA Water System to lift the “boil water advisory” for the water system.
