



Pollution Prevention Internship Program Summer 2015

An opportunity for UNM engineering students to work with local organizations helping to identify, evaluate, and implement projects with positive environmental impacts.

- 6-8 interns will provide technical assistance to businesses and other organizations during 12-week internships.
- Projects focus on principles of pollution prevention and E3 (Economy, Energy, and Environment).
- Provides interns with a 1-week P2 training seminar.
- Student stipends paid through UNM funded approximately 75% by program and 25% by facility.
