Accessing Air Emissions Inventory Reporting (AEIR)

Introduction

The Air Emissions Inventory Reporting (AEIR) system is a web-based tool used to submit emissions inventories to NMED. NMED uses this information for compliance assessment and planning purposes, to prepare statewide emissions inventory information, and to report emissions to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The Air Quality Bureau (AQB) is requiring Major Title V and Minor sources (New Source Reviews, General Construction Permit -2, -3, -5, -6, and Notice of Intents) to report annual emission data. Minor Source emissions will be collected every three years, starting in 2020 (inventory due in 2021).

This document contains instructions on how to gain access to the Secure Extranet Portal (SEP) and AEIR, as well as how to register for facilities and user roles in AEIR.

NOTE: The Electronic Subscriber Application (ESAA) form is no longer required. The Certifier is the only user that will utilize e-Manage. If the Certifier is not approved through this process, then the ESAA form must be submitted.

AEIR User Roles

There are three user roles in AEIR: Facility Administrator, Certifier, and Preparer/Submitter.

- Facility Administrator is a role that approves and disapproves Preparers/Submitters and Certifiers. AQB recommends that the Facility Administrator is someone from the parent company. Facility Administrators can approve themselves as other roles.
- Preparer/Submitter is a role that can submit data but not certify. Companies may employ consultants in this role or direct employees of the company.
- Certifier is a role that can submit data as well as certify the submittal. AEIR Certifiers are considered the owner, operator, responsible official, or company official.

Note: The Certifier must use e-Manage for identification verification. If the Certifier is not approved by Lexus Nexis, then the Electronic Subscriber Application (ESAA) form must be submitted to AQB.

How to Gain Access to AEIR

Complete online registration on the Secure Extranet Portal (SEP) by following the steps below:

9) Select your organization from the drop-down menu and associated facilities will appear. Roles can be checked through the "Select All" button or chosen individually. Select the "Register for Selected Facilities" button when finished.
