

# **Four Corners Air Quality Task Force Work Group Conference Call Notes**

#### **Erich's Power Plant Comment**

Erich suggested that the mitigation options in the Power Plant Group's "Overarching: Mercury", "Overarching: Air Deposition", and "Overarching: Asthma Studies" sections be referenced in the Monitoring Work Group's section. It was decided to include general references. Gordon reminded us to make sure that the reference to page numbers would stay tied to those sections as the whole report changes due to pending revisions.

#### **Uranium Mills and Possible Monitoring Needs**

The comment from Scott Clow to the Other Sources Work Group regarding the radionuclide monitoring at White Mesa, Utah was discussed. The question was raised as to whether or not we should recommend some background monitoring. It was decided that this type of monitoring does not directly tie into our tasks, but that we could make a reference to this potential issue in the Four Corners area.

#### **Anecdotal Comments / Information to be Added**

There was some discussion of how the group at one time had thought that including anecdotal comments from the public might be good to do. At this point, there is not enough time to solicit and incorporate these. It was agreed that somehow the rest of Erich's visibility photos should be included.

#### **Winn's Graphs**

It was agreed that Winn's graphs should be added to the deposition section.

#### **Sylvia's Response to BP's Comments**

Winn is going to contribute to Sylvia's comments, then they will be incorporated into the report.
