**Agenda Items/Issues**

**1. Status of Version 5 of Task Force Report.**

Report will be on the website by end of the week. One more draft version before the final draft is posted and available for public comment. Work is underway to allow for a web-based public comment period to last approximately 3 weeks in May and/or June.

**2. Update group on Joint Call 12/12 regarding tagging new and future option papers for Cumulative Effects Support.**

Work Group Coordinator Jen Mattox recapped the last conference call.

**3. Any discussion on CE presentation on WRAP inventory presented by CE on 1/8/07.**

Work Group Coordinator Jen Mattox recapped the ENVIRON presentation during the conference call earlier this week. Jen said there may be another opportunity to have the presentation by ENVIRON.

**4. Review Tracking Table Posted on the Oil & Gas Work Group website for any updates to the progress on outstanding papers.**

Version 5 of the Task Force Report includes 6 new papers and comments in 5 existing mitigation options.

E&P mitigation options still under development that will be included in Version 6 include the following:

- Tanks
  1. Centralized collection for new sources - Walt Brown intends to finish.
  2. Floating roof tanks - Kellie Skelton to finish.
- Dehydrators/Separators/Heaters
  3. Control glycol pump rates - Dave Brown to do.
  4. Optimization and automation - Dave Brown to do.
  5. Low and Ultralow NOx burners - Brit Benko to do.
  6. Combustors for still vents - Dave Brown to do.
  7. VRUs - Dave Brown to do.

## **5. Discuss agenda for Work Group breakout session on February 7, 2007.**

February 7 breakout session was previously designated for developing workplan for midstream operations.

Jen Mattox can do handout for workplan development and brainstorming.

Dave Brown raised question of what is definition of "midstream."

Work Group can use Oil and Gas Matrix and Oil and Gas Schedule (available online) to more accurately focus on "compressor stations, gas plants, transmission and storage facilities."

Suggestion for handout: identify and summarize NSPS and MACTs that apply at typical gas plant - Jen Mattox to compile and distribute prior to February 7.

Jen Mattox presented idea of keeping midstream section short and look into mitigation options focusing on renewables and energy efficiency.

Dave Brown will brainstorm list of renewable/energy efficiency options prior to February 7.

- Compressor station, gas plant, transmission and storage facilities mitigation options (reference handout).
- Focus on renewables/energy efficiency options.
- Discuss and prioritize options to be addressed by CE Work Group.
