[Provide DA option to the Oil and Gas work group to discuss @ May 9th meeting](#)
- Preface: Revised preface for the power plants section. Comments: include discussion of which options were brainstormed and how many were written. Include discussion of which options were not written and why. [This will be included in the Table of Mitigation Options not written at end of the report. May include some discussion in the preface \(follow-up\).](#) Call participants thought the preface was relatively well done.
- Reorganization Susan Johnson recommended moving the “Negotiated Agreements in PSD Permits Option” from Proposed section to Future Power Plants section. [Discuss at 5/9/07 meeting.](#) EEREC section to be reorganized for Version 7.
