**Saturday October 3<sup>th</sup> 2009 10am-1pm**

-----*Farmington Area*-----

**500 W. 32<sup>nd</sup> St.** Grid-tied solar electric with battery backup  
Travelling west on 30<sup>th</sup> St., turn right (north) on Sunset. Turn left on 32<sup>nd</sup> St.

**4636 Piedras and 1224 Turning Leaf** (across street from each other) **Solar thermal heating and domestic hot water. Water recycling system. Fully encapsulated reflective insulation. Sandia Labs insulation test home.**

West from Farmington on Highway 64, 0.4 mile after passing Troy King Rd. turn right (north) on Four Seasons Parkway (which is just before RUSH EQUIPMENT) Go to end of street and turn right on Piedras

**8200 San Lucas Court** Solar thermal domestic hot water  
From Pinon Hills Blvd, travel north on Foothills 2.5 miles to "T". Turn left (west) onto Cordoba Way. Go 0.4 mile (crossing Hood Mesa Trail as you do) and turn right on San Lucas Court (Note: Hood Mesa Trail can connect to house listed next)

**6255 Hood Mesa Trail** Passive solar design, Rastra block, Recycled steel, Engineered water runoffs, Existing natural landscape emphasized

From Pinon Hills Blvd, travel north on Hood Mesa Trail (its intersection with Pinon Hills Blvd is just east of Butler's intersection). Go 1.1 miles (on left)

-----*Flora Vista*-----

**8325 Old Aztec Highway** Grid-tied solar electric system. Solar thermal hybrid system with evacuated tubes. High efficiency boiler.

Travelling east from Farmington on Main St., 1.0 mile past Ziems Ford turn right on Old Aztec Highway (the turn is right beyond Memory Gardens Cemetery). Go 1.7 miles to house **Or, from the Flora Vista stoplight:** Go

south on CR 350 (formerly 3500) 0.6 mile and turn right on CR 3520 (which is the Old Aztec Highway) and proceed 0.8 mile to house

## -----Crouch Mesa-----

### **1201 Katherine Av. Innovative electric/thermal hybrid panels. Grid-tied. Zero energy home.**

Travelling east from Farmington on Highway 64, turn left (north) on Andrea Dr.(the new stoplight) Go 0.3 mile and turn right on Katherine Av

### **#5 CR 3787 . Net Zero Energy Home. Grid-tied solar electric. Efficiency built in throughout.**

From Browning Parkway go on Morningstar (northeast). Turn right on CR 3950. Go about 2.2 miles and turn left on CR 3900 (there's a stop sign here). Turn left on CR 3787. **Or:** From Dino's Market (on CR 350,formerly 3500), go west on CR 390 for 1.8 mi and turn right on CR 3900. Proceed until turning left on CR 3787

### **248 CR 3950 Solar thermal hybrid system for heating and domestic hot water. Evacuated tubes and high efficiency boiler**

From Browning Parkway go east on Wildflower Parkway (app. 3 miles) and turn left (north) on CR 3900. Go 0.6 mi and turn right on CR 3950 (there's a stop sign here but no street sign...). House is last on left. **Or:** Browning Parkway to Morningstar, turning right on 3950 and going to the very end **Or:** From Dino's Market (on CR 350, formerly 3500) go west on CR 390 for 1.8 mi and turn right on CR 3900. Go 0.6 mi to stop sign and turn right onto CR 3950 (careful, a stop sign, but no street sign) Last house on left

Please note: These Crouch Mesa homes are not far from each other. A little time with the phone book map or Mapquest could save some driving. ( i.e. Andrea connects to Wildflower)

## -----North of Aztec-----

### **42 CR 2776 Straw bale. Off grid solar electric. Solar domestic hot water. Rain water collection. Earthen plasters.**

Coming north out of Aztec on Highway 550, go to mile marker 164. Look for metal building on right "Raisebor". Turn right, beside this building, onto CR 2770. Go 5 miles on CR 2770 (gravel road in good shape). Where there is a sign "Hart Mountain Ranches" turn right onto CR 2776 and go 0.4 mile crossing a cattle guard. Turn right onto parking area just beyond a road marked private
