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10 **20.2.2.1 ISSUING AGENCY:** New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board.

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13 **20.2.2.2 SCOPE:** The provisions of this Part shall apply to all New Mexico regulations regarding air
14 quality, and codified as 20.2.3 NMAC through 20.2.99 NMAC.

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17 **20.2.2.3 STATUTORY AUTHORITY:** The Environmental Improvement Board "shall promulgate
18 regulations and standards in ... air quality management" (NMSA 1978, section 74-1-8.A) and "the Environmental
19 Improvement Board... shall adopt... regulations to attain and maintain national ambient air quality standards and
20 prevent or abate air pollution..." (NMSA 1978, section 74-2-5.B).

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30 **20.2.2.6 OBJECTIVE:** To provide specific definitions for terms used and not defined in air quality
31 regulations 20.2.3 NMAC through 20.2.99 NMAC.

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34 **20.2.2.7 DEFINITIONS:** The following definitions apply to all Parts of Title 20, Chapter 2 NMAC.

35 **A. "Administrator"** means the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency
36 (US EPA) or his or her designee.

37 **B. "Aerodynamic diameter"** means the diameter of a sphere of unit density which behaves
38 aerodynamically the same as the particle of the test substance. It is used to predict where particles of different size
39 and density may be deposited in the respiratory tract.

40 **C. "Air contaminant"** means any airborne substance, including but not limited to, any particulate
41 matter, fly ash, dust, fumes, gas, mist, smoke, vapor, micro-organisms, radioactive material, any combination
42 thereof or any decay or reaction product thereof.

43 **D. "Air pollution"** means the emission, except as such emission occurs in nature, into the outdoor
44 atmosphere of one or more air contaminants in such quantities and duration as may with reasonable probability
45 injure human health, animal or plant life, or as may unreasonable interfere with the public welfare, visibility or the
46 reasonable use of property.

47 **E. "Asbestos"** includes chrysolite, crocidolite, amosite, anthophyllite, tremolite, and actinolite.

48 **F. "Board"** means the New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board or its successor agency or
49 authority.

50 **G. "carbon dioxide"** means the chemical compound containing one atom of carbon and two atoms
51 of oxygen.

52 **H. "Carbon monoxide"** means the chemical compound containing one atom of carbon and one atom
53 of oxygen.

54 **I. "Department"** means the New Mexico Environment Department or its successor agency or
55 authority, as represented by the Department Secretary or his or her designee.

1 **IJ.** "Federal Act" means the Federal Clean Air Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. sections 7401 et seq.

2 **JK.** "Flue" means, any duct for air, gases, or the like, such as a stack or chimney.

3 **KL.** "Fugitive dust" or "Fugitive particulate matter" means particulate emissions which escape to

4 the atmosphere due to leakage; materials handling, transfer or storage; travel over unpaved roads or parking areas; or

5 other industrial activities, and which are not ducted through exhaust systems.

6 **M.** "greenhouse gas" means any of the following: carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide,

7 hydrofluorocarbons, perfluorocarbons or sulfur hexafluoride.

8 **LN.** "Heavy metal" means any metal having an atomic number greater than 21.

9 **O.** "hydrofluorocarbons" means gaseous chemical compounds containing only hydrogen, carbon,

10 and fluorine atoms.

11 **MP.** "Hydrogen sulfide" means the chemical compound containing two atoms of hydrogen and one

12 atom of sulfur.

13 **NQ.** "Kraft pulp" means the fibrous cellulose material produced in a Kraft mill.

14 **OR.** "Lead" means elemental lead; alloys in which one of the elements is lead; or compounds

15 containing lead, which are measured as elemental lead.

16 **S.** "methane" means the chemical compound containing one atom of carbon and four atoms of

17 hydrogen.

18 **PI.** "mg/m3" means milligrams per cubic meter.

19 **QU.** "Nitrogen dioxide" means the chemical compound containing one atom of nitrogen and two

20 atoms of oxygen, for the purposes of ambient determinations. The term "nitrogen dioxide," for the purposes of stack

21 emissions monitoring, shall include nitrogen dioxide (the chemical compound containing one atom of nitrogen and

22 two atoms of oxygen), nitric oxide (the chemical compound containing one atom of nitrogen and one atom of

23 oxygen), and other oxides of nitrogen which may test as nitrogen dioxide.

24 **V.** "nitrous oxide" means the chemical compound containing two atoms of nitrogen and one atom of

25 oxygen.

26 **RW.** "Non-methane hydrocarbons" means any combination of hydrocarbons (chemical compounds

27 consisting of hydrogen and carbon) excluding only the molecule methane.

28 **SX.** "Ozone" means the chemical compound having the molecular composition of three oxygen

29 atoms.

30 **FY.** "Particulate matter" means any airborne, finely divided solid or liquid material with an

31 aerodynamic diameter smaller than 100 micrometers.

32 **UZ.** "Particulate matter emissions" means all finely divided solid or liquid material, other than

33 uncombined water, emitted to the ambient air as measured by: applicable reference methods; an equivalent or

34 alternative method specified by the Administrator; or a test method specified in the New Mexico State

35 Implementation Plan.

36 **AA.** "perfluorocarbons" means gaseous chemical compounds containing only carbon and fluorine

37 atoms.

38 **VAB.** "Person" means any individual; partnership; corporation; association; municipality; the State or

39 political subdivision of the State; and any agency, department, or instrumentality of the United States and any of

40 their officers, agents, or employees.

41 **WAC.** "Photochemical oxidants" means those oxidizing chemical compounds which are the products of

42 photo initiated reactions involving organic compounds and nitrogen oxides, consisting primarily of ozone and

43 peroxyacetyl nitrate (PAN).

44 **XAD.** "PM10" means particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter less than or equal to a nominal

45 10 micrometers.

46 **YAE.** "PM10 emissions" means finely divided solid or liquid material with an aerodynamic diameter

47 less than or equal to a nominal 10 micrometers, emitted to the ambient air, as measured by: an applicable reference

48 method; an equivalent or alternative method specified by the EPA Administrator; or a test method specified in the

49 New Mexico State Implementation Plan.

50 **ZAF.** "ppm" means parts per million by volume.

51 **AAAG.** "Ringelmann scale" means the grading of opacity, appearance, density or shade of a smoke

52 emission, in determining the light-obscuring power of smoke.

53 **ABAH.** "Schedule of compliance" means a schedule or timetable, acceptable to the Board, which clearly

54 sets out in detail, the steps to be taken in achieving the objectives of a regulation or standard.

55 **ACAI.** "Secretary" means the Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department or his or her

56 designee.

1 **ADAJ.** "Smoke" means small gas-borne particles resulting from incomplete combustion, consisting
2 predominantly, by not exclusively, of carbon, soot and combustible material.

3 **AEAK.** "Sulfur dioxide" means the chemical compound containing one atom of sulfur and two atoms of
4 oxygen, for the purposes of ambient determinations. The term sulfur dioxide, for the purposes of stack emissions
5 monitoring, shall include sulfur dioxide (chemical compound containing one atom of sulfur and two atoms of
6 oxygen), and other oxides of sulfur which may test as sulfur dioxide.

7 **AL.** "sulfur hexafluoride" means the chemical compound containing one atom of sulfur and six
8 atoms of fluorine.

9 **AFAM.** "Total reduced sulfur" means any combination of sulfur compounds, except sulfur dioxide and
10 free sulfur, which test as total reduced sulfur, including, but not limited to, hydrogen sulfide, methyl mercaptan, and
11 ethyl mercaptan.

12 **AGAN.** "Total suspended particulates (TSP)" means particulate matter as measured by the method
13 described in 40 CFR Part 50, Appendix B.

14 **AHAO.** "ug/m3" means micrograms per cubic meter.

15 **AIAP.** "US EPA" means the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

16 **AJAQ.** "Volatile organic compound (VOC)" means any organic compound which participates in
17 atmospheric photochemical reactions; that is, any organic compound other than those which the Administrator
18 designates as having negligible photochemical reactivity.
