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Notification - NMED’s 2012 Title V Greenhouse Gas Reporting Requirements and Guidance

Pursuant to 20.2.73 NMAC - Notice Of Intent And Emissions Inventory Requirements, Greenhouse Gas Emissions (“GHG”) data for emissions year 2012 are required to be submitted to NMED from Title V sources subject to permit requirements under 20.2.70 NMAC. At this time, NMED will not be providing guidance regarding GHG reporting required by 20.2.300 NMAC – Reporting of Greenhouse Gas Emissions because there’s a petition to repeal these rules in front of the New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board (“EIB”). Once the EIB makes a decision on the petition, NMED will take the appropriate action regarding GHG reporting requirements and update these procedures and guidance, if necessary.
