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Notification - NMED’s 2015 Title V Greenhouse Gas Reporting Requirements and Guidance - FINAL

Pursuant to 20.2.73 NMAC - Notice Of Intent And Emissions Inventory Requirements, Greenhouse Gas Emissions (“GHG”) data for emissions year 2015 are required to be submitted to NMED from Title V sources subject to permit requirements under 20.2.70 NMAC.
