- If it is a mold concern in a **Residential** building interior, please refer to the New Mexico Department of Health, Environmental Health Epidemiology Bureau (EHEB).
- EHEB manages indoor air issues in the state, including mold problems.
- EHEB does not have regulatory authority; they provide guidance for mitigation of indoor air quality issues, such as mold.
