Air Quality Permit Application Information:

DCP Midstream, L.P., 10 Desta Drive, Suite 400, Midland, Texas has submitted an air quality permit application to the Air Quality Bureau (AQB), New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality permit to modify the Linam Ranch Gas Plant. The application file has been assigned Permit No. 0039-M7 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 589. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 32 deg, 41 min, 49.0558 sec and longitude -103 deg, 16 min, 53.5558 sec. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 7 miles west of Hobbs, NM in Lea County.
