

LEGAL NOTICE

Air Quality Operating Permit

for Eunice B&C Compressor Station of El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C.

El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. at 5151 East Broadway, Suite 1680; Tucson, AZ 85711 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Eunice B&C Compressor Station. The owner of this plant is El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 32 deg, 31 min, 14 sec and longitude -103 deg, 17 min, 15.03 sec, Datum: WGS84. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 8.13 miles northwest of Eunice, NM in Lea county. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P251-R1 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 669.

The facility was not required to obtain an air quality construction permit and is in operation. The main purpose of the facility is to compress natural gas for the purpose of transportation to another facility. This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves incorporating all changes from NSR1009M1-R4 and NSR1009M2R1-M2R2.

Emissions are expressed in tons per year (tpy). Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x) at 171.3 tpy (+0.9); Carbon Monoxide (CO) at 97.7 tpy (+0.5); Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 53.2 tpy (-15.9); Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) at 13.3 tpy (no change); Particulate Matter 10 microns or less (PM₁₀) at 5.9 tpy (not previously reported) , and Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less (PM_{2.5}) at 5.9 tpy (not previously reported); and greenhouse gas (CO₂e) 96.601 tpy (not previously reported).

The estimated maximum air pollutant emissions to the atmosphere, from this facility after the requested operating permit is issued, are as follows. The facility is a minor, < 100,000 tpy CO₂e, source of greenhouse gas emissions.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance. The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, 75, 77, and 82; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A, GG, KKKK, JJJJ; 40 CFR 63 Subparts A, ZZZZ; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before February 8, 2017.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P251-R1 by contacting Roslyn Higgin at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816. Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
