Air Quality Operating Permit  
for American Gypsum - Bernalillo (Wallboard) Plant of American Gypsum Company

American Gypsum Company at P.O. Box 90820, Albuquerque, NM, 87199 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its American Gypsum - Bernalillo (Wallboard) Plant. The owner of this plant is American Gypsum Company. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 35 deg, 19 min, 50.6238 sec and longitude -106 deg, 31 min, 33.4315 sec. The facility's address is 1000 North Hills Road, Bernalillo, NM 87004. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P225R2 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 1104.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is able to operate. The main purpose of the facility is to produce wallboard from raw gypsum. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves renewing the operating permit. There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 1, 7, 13, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 77; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A and OOO; 40 CFR 64; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before 8/27/2015.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P225R2 by contacting Marvin Mascareñas at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.

The permit application, draft permit and relevant supporting materials are currently available for review at the Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.
