

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Air Quality Operating Permit  
for Roswell Compressor Station of El Paso Natural Gas Company, LLC

El Paso Natural Gas Company, LLC at 5151 East Broadway Blvd., Suite 1680; Tucson, AZ 85711 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Roswell Compressor Station. The owner of this plant is El Paso Natural Gas Company, LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 33 deg, 42 min, 42.9 sec and longitude -104 deg, 32 min, 58.2 sec. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 22.5 miles north of Roswell on US Hwy 285 and 1.2 miles east of US Hwy 285 on County Road 100/Red Bluff Road in Chaves County. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P128-R3 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 6.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to compress pipeline quality natural gas for transportation through transmission pipelines.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves a Title V permit renewal with the addition of routine startup, shutdown and scheduled maintenance and malfunction emissions previously permitted in NSR permit 3375-M1 issued November 20, 2012.

The emissions, as established in NSR Permit 3375-M1 and brought forward into this permit are as follows. Parentheses note changes in emissions from previous operating permit – P128-R2. Emissions are expressed in tons per year (tpy). Nitrogen Oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) at 236.4 tpy (no change); Carbon Monoxide (CO) at 236.4 tpy (no change); Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 58.3 tpy (+10); Sulfur Dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) at 5.1 tpy (no change) and greenhouse gas (CO<sub>2</sub>e) < 75,000 tpy.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73; 40 CFR 50 and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before January 31, 2015.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P128-R3 by contacting Daren Zigich at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
