Air Quality Operating Permit
for Corralitos Landfill of South Central Solid Waste Authority

South Central Solid Waste Authority at 2865 West Amador Avenue, Fairacres, NM 88033 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Corralitos Landfill. The owner of this plant is the South Central Solid Waste Authority. The exact location of the facility is/will be at latitude 32 deg, 14 min, 25 sec and longitude -107 deg, 1 min, 49 sec. To aid in locating this facility, the street address is 14535 Robert Larson Blvd., Las Cruces, NM in Doña Ana County. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P188L and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 175.

The facility was not required to obtain an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to serve as a municipal solid waste (MSW) landfill. The facility is currently authorized to dispose of MSW, construction waste and petroleum contaminated soils (PCS).

This operating permit application is for a new permit.

The estimated maximum air pollutant emissions to the atmosphere, from this facility after the requested operating permit is issued, are as follows. Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 15 tpy; Particulate Matter 10 microns or less (PM₁₀) at 10 tpy, and Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less (PM_{2.5}) at 2 tpy; and greenhouse gas (CO₂e) > 75,000 tpy.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 64, 70, 73, and 77; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A and WWW; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before December 19, 2015.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P188L by contacting Daren Zigich at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
