Air Quality Operating Permit
for West Eunice Compressor Station of Southern Union Gas Services Ltd

Southern Union Gas Services Ltd at 600 N. Marienfeld Street Suite 700; Midland, TX 79701 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its West Eunice Compressor Station. The owner of this plant is Southern Union Gas Services Ltd. The exact location of the facility is/will be at latitude 32 deg, 25 min, 41.2123 sec and longitude -103 deg, 12 min, 40.1501 sec. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 2.9 miles west of Eunice in Lea County, New Mexico. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P242-R1M2 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 755.

Previously, the plant received an air quality construction permit and is in operation. This facility is a natural gas compressor station. The major processes associated with the facility are the removal of liquids from field gas and the compression of natural gas.

This operating permit application is for a permit modification. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves removing the applicability of 40 CFR 64, Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) due to recent compliance testing, and updates based on previous like-kind engine replacements.

There are no changes in emissions in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance status.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this plant will comply with the requirements of New Mexico Administrative Code 20.2.7, 20.2.61, 20.2.70, 20.2.71, 20.2.72, 20.2.73, 40 CFR 50, 40 CFR 60, Subpart JJJJ, 40 CFR 63, Subpart ZZZZ, and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before June 29, 2013.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P242-R1M2. Contact the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, Operating Permit Unit, 1301 Siler Rd, Bldg B, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87507-3113.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
