

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
For  
Air Quality Operating Permit  
for Cedar Hill Central Delivery Point of Williams Four Corners LLC

Williams Four Corners LLC at 188 County Road 4900; Bloomfield, NM 87413 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Cedar Hill Central Delivery Point. The owner of this plant is Williams Four Corners LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 36 deg, 57 min, 7 sec and longitude -107 deg, 53 min, 44 sec. To aid in locating this facility, Drive north from Aztec on Hwy 550 to mile marker 24.7. Turn left on CR 2300 and drive 0.3 miles. Turn left and drive 0.2 miles to site. This facility is located approximately 2 miles NW of Cedar Hill in San Juan County, New Mexico. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P036-R3 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 1227.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to compress and dehydrate natural gas for pipeline transmission.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves updating equipment information and permit wording to comply with current permit template language.

There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 82; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 63 Subparts A, HH and ZZZZ; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before June 6, 2015.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P036-R3 by contacting Daren Zigich at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
