Air Quality Permit Application Information:

Western Refining Southwest Inc - 92 Giant Crossing Rd, Gallup, NM has submitted an air quality permit application to the Air Quality Bureau (AQB), New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality permit to modify the Wingate Fractionating Plant. The application file has been assigned Permit No. 1313-M6 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 884. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 35 degrees, 32 minutes, 8.0 seconds and longitude -108 degrees, 38 minutes, 22.6 seconds. This facility is located approximately six miles east of Gallup, in McKinley County, New Mexico.

Expected Date of Permit Issuance: on or before October 11, 2015.
