Air Quality Operating Permit
for the Lybrook Gas Plant of Williams Four Corners, LLC

Williams Four Corners, LLC at 188 County Road 4900, Bloomfield, NM 87413 has submitted an application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for the Lybrook Gas Plant. The owner of this plant is Williams Four Corners, LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 36 deg., 13 min., 52 sec. and longitude -107 deg., 32 min., 46 sec. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 50 miles south of Bloomfield, NM on US 550. This facility is located approximately 4.5 miles WNW of Counselor in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P098-R2 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 979.

Previously, the plant received an air quality construction permit and is in operation. The main purpose of the plant is to process and produce pipeline quality natural gas and to produce natural gas liquids, including y-grade, propane, butane, and higher hydrocarbons.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action does not involve any equipment modifications or changes in operations at the facility.

There are no changes in emissions associated with this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance status.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this plant will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 1, 7, 37, 70, 71, 72, 73, 75, 77, and 82; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 60, Subparts A and GG; 40 CFR 63, Subparts A and CCCCCC; 40 CFR 64; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before December 21, 2011.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P098-R2. Contact the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, Operating Permit Unit, 1301 Siler Rd, Bldg B, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87507-3113.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
