

## Summary of Corrales Air Quality Task Force

In November, 2002, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) formed the Corrales Air Quality Task Force to give input to the Department on NMED's air quality study funded by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

**December, 2002 to June, 2004**

### Summary of Intel Technical Meetings:

**February 13, 2003 to March 24, 2003**<sup>4</sup>

In addition to Task Force meetings, a series of meetings were held over approximately 6 weeks to address public questions related to Intel, its operations and the regulation of Intel by NMED.

- 60 separate individuals attended one or more of these meetings
- 250 hours of community time spent at, and preparing for, these meetings
- 520 hours of time spent by Intel and NMED staff to answer the questions asked
- 105 questions were submitted and answered
