What is San Juan VISTAS?

- San Juan VISTAS is a voluntary emission control program administered by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for the improvement of air quality.
- The purpose of San Juan VISTAS is to identify, promote, and implement practices and technologies to reduce emissions that contribute to smog and greenhouse gas emissions
- Private and public entities can participate in VISTAS. Companies, municipalities, organizations, and community groups are invited to participate.

- To qualify for participation in San Juan VISTAS, technologies and practices employed for emissions reductions must be above and beyond regulatory requirements.
- Companies and groups that choose to participate in the program are recognized by NMED as Clean Air Partners.
- Companies and groups that are interested in becoming a Clean Air Partner should contact the New Mexico Environment Department and sign a **Voluntary Agreement**.
