### What is San Juan VISTAS?

- San Juan VISTAS (Voluntary Innovative Strategies for Today's Air Standards) is a voluntary emission control program administered by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for the improvement of air quality.
- The purpose of San Juan VISTAS is to identify, promote, and implement practices and technologies to reduce emissions that contribute to ozone, haze, and climate change.

### Who Can Join?

- Private and public entities can participate in VISTAS. Companies, municipalities, organizations, and community groups are invited to participate.
- To qualify for participation in San Juan VISTAS, technologies and practices employed for emissions reductions must be above and beyond regulatory requirements.

### Why Join?

- Help improve the air quality of the Four Corners.
- Be recognized for going above and beyond standard air emission regulations. Companies and groups that choose to participate in the program are recognized by NMED as Clean Air Partners.
- Share technology and ideas to help other entities reduce air pollution.

### Become a Clean Air Partner

Interested groups and companies sign a Voluntary Agreement with the NMED's Air Quality Bureau. NMED can assist a Clean Air Partner by analyzing technologies and practices for emissions reductions.
