

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT**  
**Draft Report: 2010 Regional SO<sub>2</sub> Emissions and Milestone Report**

New Mexico's state implementation plan for regional haze, adopted by the Environmental Improvement Board on November 18, 2003, requires that New Mexico coordinate with other states in producing an annual report to determine if emissions of sulfur dioxide from large industrial sources are less than the emissions milestone set in the plan. The plan also requires the states to prepare an audit of the milestone report in 2006 and 2011. An audit was prepared in 2006. The states have reviewed that audit for 2011. In addition, the states are required to prepare a projection of 2018 emissions in 2013. The states have prepared the 2018 emissions projection.

The draft 2010 Regional SO<sub>2</sub> Emissions and Milestone report, audit review report, and 2018 emissions projection are now available for public comment and can be found on the Air Quality website, [http://www.nmenv.state.nm.us/aqb/reghaz/regional-haze\\_index.html](http://www.nmenv.state.nm.us/aqb/reghaz/regional-haze_index.html), or you may contact the New Mexico Air Quality Bureau for a copy of the report at (505) 476-4329 or by mail at the address below.

The States and the WRAP will respond to any comments and then provide notice of the final availability of the report before submitting the report as final to the EPA.
