## The New Mexico Environment Department is seeking public participation and comments on the proposed amendments to 20.10.2 NMAC

The Cannabis and Hemp Bureau has, developed a draft of the proposed amendments, to New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) 20.10.2. The objective of the Hemp Post-harvest Processing rule is to protect public health by establishing standards and provisions for the safe operation of hemp facilities to ensure that consumers are not exposed to adverse environmental health conditions.

Members of the public are encouraged to review the proposed amendments, attend public meetings, and provide comments.
