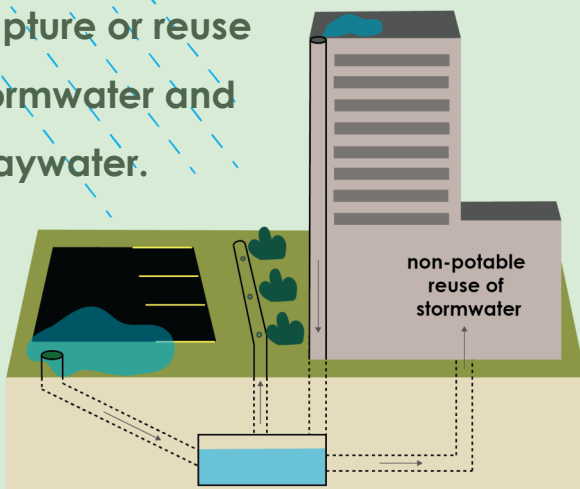

# Examples of CWSRF Eligible Projects

## Water Recycling

Manage, reduce, treat, capture or reuse stormwater and graywater.



## Water Quality Protection from Resource Extraction

Treatment or reuse of wastewater; prevention or remediation of contaminants from mining, hydraulic fracking, oil/gas operations.

## Contaminated Site Remediation

Site restoration for industrial use; removal and/or replacement of leaking storage tanks to protect water quality.

## Management of Agricultural Runoff

Distribution of reclaimed water for irrigation or reduction in runoff/erosion from cropland.
