

# *Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program*

- ❖ Loan Program
- ❖ Provides financial assistance for engineering, construction, and rehabilitation of eligible projects
- ❖ Technical and Financial assistance available




# *Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program*

# *CWSRF Funding Cycle*

- ❖ Invitations to apply mailed in January
- ❖ Applications submitted thru the online UFA by 2/28/xx (*Also submit letter of interest to NMED/CPB*)
- ❖ Applications are prioritized according to need and public benefit (March)
- ❖ Notification of rankings (April)
- ❖ Opportunity for public comment (May)
- ❖ Funding available in July



# *Rural Infrastructure Program Revolving Loan Fund (RIP)*

# *Rural Infrastructure Program Revolving Loan Fund*

- Loan program
- Eligible entities
- Eligible expenses



# *RIP Loan Program Details*

- ❖ State funded program: quick funding window
- ❖ Avail for construction or modification of water supply, solid waste (includes *recycling* projects) and wastewater facilities.
- ❖ Low cost loans for municipalities that serve populations of less than 20,000 AND Counties with populations less than 200,000



## *RIP Loan Program Details (cont.)*

- ❖ Maximum loan amount is \$2,000,000 per year
- ❖ Interest rate is 3%
- ❖ Repayment period of up to 20 years



# *Requirements of the RIP Loan*

Two important considerations:

- ❖ 20.7.2.202 (2) financial capability of the local authority to repay the loan.
- ❖ 20.7.2.202 (3) readiness to proceed with the project



# *Program Summary*

- ❖ CPB projects have a significant effect on protecting the environment and improving the New Mexico economy: 802 active construction projects totaling \$235 million.
- ❖ CPB is a customer service Bureau striving to improve New Mexico's water utilities.



# *Money to Lend!*

- ❖ Approx \$10 million in RIP (*now*)
- ❖ Approx \$6 million in CWSRF (FY10)
