The Construction Programs Bureau has scheduled a meeting to brief stakeholders and other interested members of the public on proposed amendments to the following regulations:

- 20.7.2 NMAC – *Rural Water Supply Infrastructure*;
- 20.7.5 NMAC – *Wastewater Facility Construction Loans*; and
- 20.7.6 NMAC – *Wastewater Facility Construction Loan Policies and Guidelines*.

The meeting is scheduled for August 16, 2007 in the 1st floor auditorium of the Harold Runnels Building, 1190 St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, NM at 9:00 a.m.



CPB: Partners in Assisting Communities with Loan & Grant Funds

The Department proposes the amendments to conform to changes made to the Rural Infrastructure Act and the Wastewater Facility Construction Loan Act during the 2007 legislative session:

20.7.2 NMAC - Rural Water Supply Infrastructure – Raising the cap on loans from \$500,000 to \$2,000,000; expanding the scope of eligible communities; making solid waste disposal projects eligible for funding; and allowing for administrative costs.

20.7.5 NMAC - Wastewater Facility Construction Loans and 20.7.6 NMAC - Wastewater Facility Construction Loan Policies and Guidelines – Allowing for administrative costs; adding definitions; and clarifying language.
